

CLASS IV INFRARED LASER spells R-E-L-I-E-F

The cases listed below were all seen at Functional Imaging and Assessment with the Avicenna Class IV Laser.

Small Fiber Neuropathy

RC was disabled by small fiber neuropathy in her lower legs; when she came here her feet were purple. Infrared imaging located an injury on her left great toe. Laser applied to her foot corrected the damaged nerve in three visits and her feet returned to normal for the first time in eight years.

Complex Regional Pain Syndrome following back surgery

TH is 47. A work related injury led to back surgery five years ago. 6 days following surgery he began to notice burning pain and swelling in his right foot. Two years later it went into his left foot. At the time of his first visit with us, both feet were discolored, swollen, and the patient complained of burning pain, like he was walking on glass. When we applied the laser therapy to the skin over his surgical scar the intensity of pain in his feet immediately began to less whereby he could walk with less pain.

Failed back surgery; Addiction to Pain relieving medication

At age 51, HF had undergone back surgery five times. His first one was 15 years ago for a work related injury. His pain was worse than before the surgery and shooting into his left leg. Unfortunately, his constant pain led to addiction to the medication and the medical community abandoned him. When he arrived here he used two canes and the assistance of his wife to move. Three months later HF walks unassisted and went fishing for the first time in six years.

Wheel chair to walking

FP is a seventy six year old female with unrelenting lower back pain. She was confined to wheelchair when we first met. Prior treatment in medical and chiropractic offices proved to be futile. Category IV Laser therapy to the lesion found with Infrared Imaging allowed FP to graduate to a walker, then to four-point cane, later a one point cane and now, three months later, she forgets her cane!

TMJ

Patient A. G. had suffered jaw (TMJ) and facial pain for over 9 years. She couldn't smile, eat many foods, or talk clearly. After eight different doctors, and a sinus surgery none of which helped, the laser brought relief. After the first treatment, her right jaw was "not grinding". After the eighth treatment, there was "hardly any pain". She can now eat whatever she wants, and smile whenever she wants.

Plantar Fascitis

Patient S. A. had plantar fascitis (pain on the bottom of the foot) for nine months with a misdiagnosis of peripheral neuropathy. Six laser treatments later she is can stay on her feet during the entire day; she continues to have the laser therapy periodically.

Wisdom Teeth

Patient J. had four wisdom teeth removed and couldn't tolerate the pain medicine. One week after having the teeth removed, pain prohibited good sound sleep. One laser treatment in the morning, and her pain was significantly reduced. One later in the afternoon and she had her first pain free night since her surgery.

Knee Pain

P. S. had right knee pain for six months. She noticed significant pain decrease after one session. Seven sessions later, she has little pain and her recovery is continuing.

L. S. endured knee pain for decades, and after laser treatment, at age 60 he can do things he didn't even think about doing like using the Stairmaster, and cross-country skiing.

Rheumatoid Arthritis

M. S. was diagnosed with rheumatoid arthritis. At age 46, she could barely move her right ring finger and little finger. She had one laser session. Two months later, her fingers move as well as they ever could.

Sinus Pain

J. B., C. W., C. M., L. B., all experienced immediate, long lasting relief from sinus pain and pressure with one session.

L. W. has rheumatoid arthritis. Monthly sessions keep her joints loose, pain free, and shrink the nodules on her joints.

C. P. had neck pain, headache, and sinus fullness. After one session, her sinuses were clear, and her head and neck pain were gone.

Mr. M. has had gout in his big toes for years. He could not bend or flex his big toes. After four sessions of laser treatment on his toes, they move freely and without pain.

Patient J.H. had an aphthous ulcer (similar to a canker sore) high up on her gum. She had had it for one week and was looking at another week or two of mouth pain. After one laser treatment, there was no pain until she ate lunch. After lunch she had another treatment, and there was no pain until dinner. The next day the ulcer had shrunk to half its size, (verified by the doctor she worked for), and one more treatment she was completely pain free.
